19th EDITION INTERNATIONAL PRIZE FOR ILLUSTRATION

Aware of the importance of illustration in children's books, Fundación SM invites entries for the **2009 International Prize for Illustration**. The purpose of this prize is to support and promote artists whose work is aimed at children.

The **CONDITIONS** of entry are as follows:

- 1 All unpublished illustrated works aimed at children of under eight years of age may be entered for the prize. In these works, the illustration must not be simply an accessory, but should be as important as the text. The prize will be awarded for both the text and the illustration.
- 2 The works may be presented in any of the languages of Spain (Spanish, Catalan, Basque or Galician). If the work was originally written in any language other than these, the text must be accompanied by a translation in English or Spanish.
- 3 The following may enter for the prize: a) one person: the author of both the text and the illustration; b) two people: one, the author of the text, and the other, the illustrator; c) a team of several people.
- 4 One prize, of **12,000 euros**, will be awarded.
- 5 Participants will be responsible for sending their works and will pay the expense of the same.
- 6 When the prize has been awarded, the originals will be at the author or authors' disposal at Grupo SM's head office for two months as from the date of the Prize. When this period comes to an end, they will be destroyed. Return of the non-winning originals may be requested through e-mail to: maria.merchan@grupo-sm.com. Authors may collect them in person or request they be returned by registered post (the publisher takes no responsibility for any damage or loss which the original might suffer if they are sent by registered post).
- 7 The originals must be submitted between **1 and 31 January 2009**. The winner will be announced in March 2009.
- 8 Ediciones SM reserves the right to the first option to publish the winning work. This option must be exercised in the two years subsequent to the date the prize was awarded. The amount of the prize money will not be deducted from the royalties stipulated in the publishing contract.
- 9 The following requisites must be met to enter the work for the prize. The complete text of the work must be presented; this must not be longer than **two pages** typewritten with double space (approximately thirty lines per page and seventy strokes per line). **Four pages of completed illustrations and a general sketch of the book** must be presented. The sketch should reflect the **24 pages** of text and illustrations of the book in its final version.
- 10 The originals will fit proportionally into the format of **20.5 x 27 cm**, and in no case will exceed **45 cm** in any of its measurements. Any technique that can be reproduced may be used. Rigid materials should be avoided.

Six copies of the text must be included. Participants may send as many works as they wish.

12 The panel of judges will be formed by five members designated by Fundación SM.

13 The panel's decision may not be appealed against, and the prize may be declared void.

14 The presentation of a work for the International Prize for Illustration implies authors' express acceptance of these conditions.

15 Staff of Fundación SM and Grupo SM may not submit works for this prize.
